Recall the Facts

1. What was Hitler's job when he discovered the DAP?

An army spy.

2. What did Hitler like about the DAP?

It was against the Weimar Republic and the Treaty of Versailles.

3. Give 2 points from Hitler's 25-point programme.

Opposed to the Weimar Government and the Treaty of Versailles, anti-democracy, antisemitic – blamed the Jews for the economic problems of Germany.

4. Why were Hitler's speeches persuasive?

He used persuasive techniques such as drawing the audience in, showing passion using shouts and hand gestures, and escalating his volume and language.

5. What did Hitler change the DAP's name to?

The NSDAP or Nazi for short.

6. How did the branding of the swastika and the straight arm salute help the Nazis grow?

It was clear who they were and set them apart from other similar parties.

7. Why was it important for Hitler to select the right leaders in the early days of the Nazi Party?

He needed to make sure they were suitable for the job and would be loyal to Hitler.

8. What was the purpose of the SA?

They helped to control members of the party and be loyal to Hitler.

9. Why did Hitler create the SS?

He didn't trust the SA and needed a bodyguard.

10. What did Hitler achieve at the 1922 party conference?

He persuaded the membership to make him leader.
