1. Why did Stresemann need to improve relations with foreign countries?  
**To build confidence in the Weimar Republic and restore national pride.**
2. Which countries were part of the Locarno Pact (1925)?  
**Germany, Britain, Italy, France & Belgium**
3. What did the Locarno Pact (1925) decide?  
**It confirmed some of the terms of the Treaty of Versailles and allowed Germany to apply to become a member of the League of Nations**
4. Why was the Locarno Pact (1925) accepted by many in Germany?  
**Germany had an equal say in the outcome.**
5. What was the League of Nations?  
**A group of countries which met to discuss world problems and to prevent wars.**
6. Which two countries, importantly, did not immediately join the League of Nations?  
**Germany and the USA**
7. Why did Germany want to join the League of Nations?  
**It would give them equality with other countries in Europe.**
8. What did the Kellogg-Briand Pact agree?  
**It promised the countries would not use war to achieve their aims.**
9. How far did support for the extreme parties in Germany fall in the latter half of the 1920s?  
**From 40% to 28%**
10. Who replaced Ebert as President? Why was he popular?  
**He was a moderate and had been the Field Marshall in the Kaiser's army.**
