Anger over the Armistice and the Treaty of Versailles, increase in support for extreme parties, Local officials did not intervene.

2. Name one short term cause of the Munich Putsch.

Invasion of the Ruhr and Hyperinflation.

8th – 9th November 1923

4. Which ex-army general supported the Munich Putsch?

Ludendorff.
