The protests started in October 1956 when the Hungarian people, Fed up with Fuel and Food shortages, as well as the lack of political Freedom under the Soviet controlled government, protested in the streets of Budapest. Evidence - Provide some facts or detail

The government responded with force by sending troops and tanks.

However, the protests continued, and Khrushchev, the leader of the USSR wanted to stop the protests because the world could see the Hungarian people didn't want to be under communist control. He appointed, Imre Nagy, who brought in a series of reforms including allowing non-communist parties to stand in government, free elections, and the release of political prisoners.

At first Khrushchev allowed these reforms because it did seem to be working.

However, when Nagy announced on the 1st of November that Hungary was going to leave the Warsaw Pact, Khrushchev changed his mind.

He sent 1000 tanks and 200,000 soldiers to stop the protests.

He could not risk allowing one country to leave because it may lead to other countries leaving also. The Hungarian people did not stand a chance against the tanks and were defeated. Despite this they continued to resist, leading to the deaths of 20,000 civilians.

The Soviet Union took back control of Hungary by November 10th, despite the citizens appeals to the west for help.
