Paragraph 1

Point: The Wall Street Crash had serious effects on Germany which led to a rise in support for the Nazis.

Evidence: Following the Wall Street Crash, many businesses went bust and by 1932 6 million Germans were unemployed. There was a huge increase in violence and theft and many Germans were left homeless.

Explain: This led to an increase in support for the Nazis because the Hitler seemed like a strong leader and he promised to give the workers 'work and bread', he also promised to protect the wealthier from the Communists. This led to the Nazis winning 38% of the vote in July 1932, which made the Nazis the biggest party in the Reichstag. This meant that Hitler could now demand to be made chancellor.

Analysis: This is a really important reason because if the Nazis had not been able to get the largest share of the vote, Hitler would not have been made chancellor. However, it was not enough on its own because the president hated Hitler and didn't want to make him chancellor.

Paragraph 2

Point: Hindenburg hated Hitler but was persuaded by von Papen to make him chancellor.

Evidence:

Analysis: Von Papen's decision to make Hitler chancellor was fatal. Without this and von Hindenburg's agreement, Hitler was unlikely to become chancellor. However it was the success of the Nazis in the elections that forced them to make this decision.

Paragraph 3

Point: Hitler used the depression to promote the Nazis and the SA to disrupt other parties, leading to him gaining the largest share of the vote.
